Brunelleschi was the most famous architect who built the Cathedral of Florence.

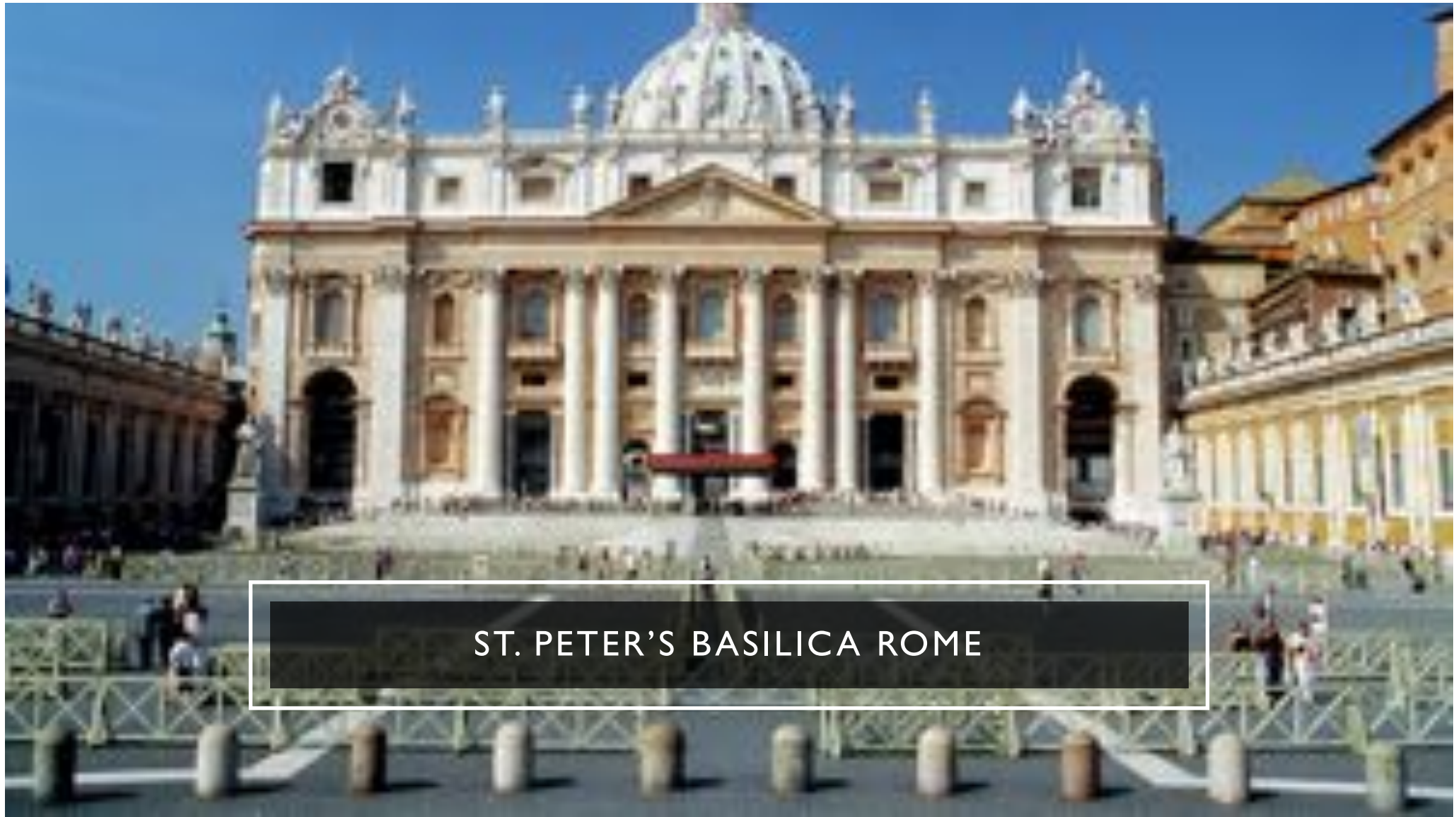






Brunelleschi's Dome
