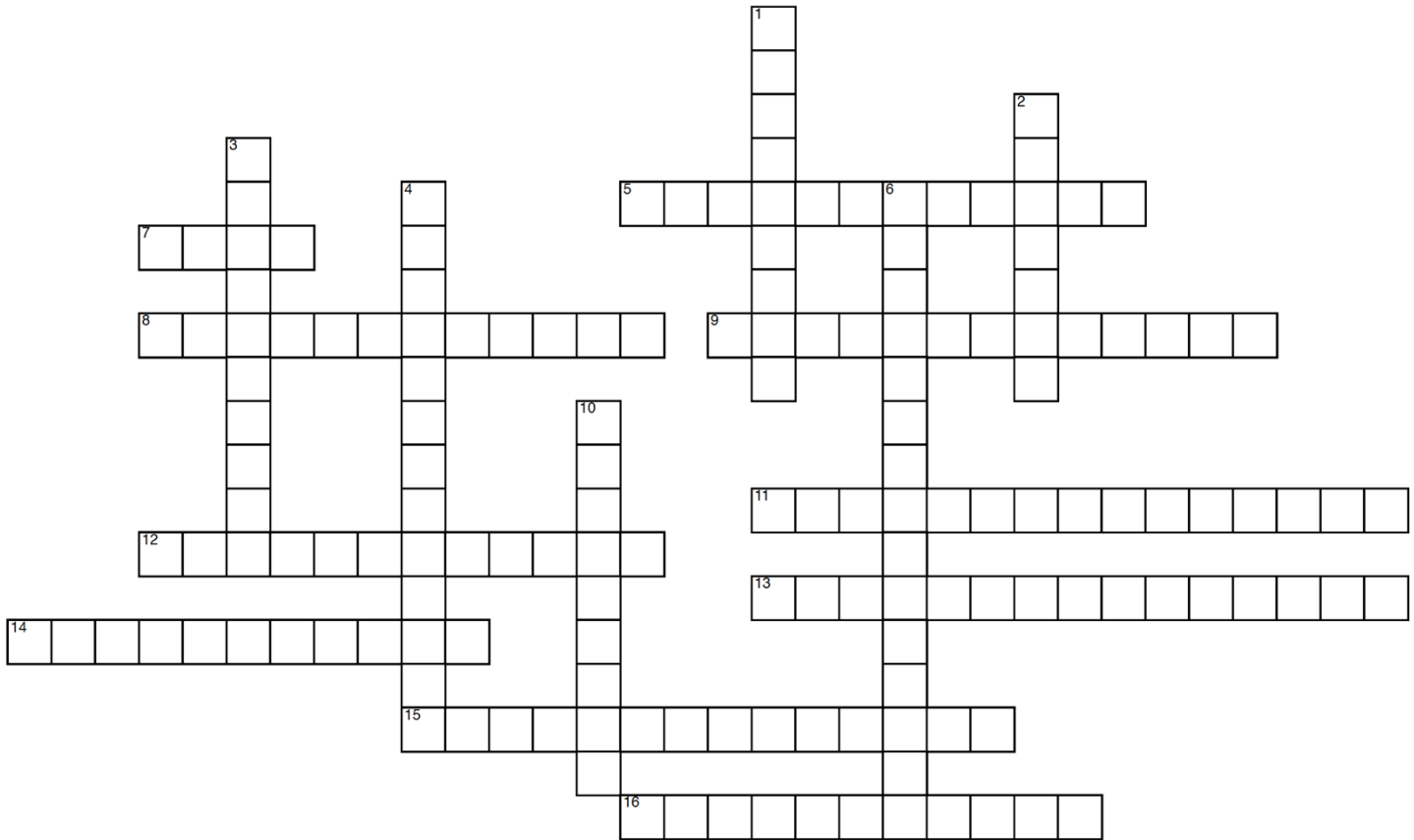

ACROSS

- 5 leader of the Soviet Union during World War II and much of the Cold War
- 7 North Atlantic Treaty Organization, a defensive military alliance formed in 1949 by ten Western European countries, the United States, and Canada
- 8 the program, proposed by the Secretary of State George Marshall in 1947, under which the United States supplied economic aid to European nations to help them rebuild after World War II
- 9 an international peacekeeping organization to which most nations in the world belong, founded in 1945 to promote world peace, security, and economic development
- 11 conference held in 1945 with U.S., Great Britain, and the Soviet Union to determine the fate of Germany at the end of World War II
- 12 38 degrees north latitude which divides North Korea from South Korea, as World War II ended, Japanese troops north of this line surrendered to the Soviets while Japanese troops south of the line surrendered to the Americans
- 13 war that broke out in China between the Nationalists and Communists, the Communists eventually won and the Nationalists fled to Taiwan
- 14 a phrase used by Winston Churchill in 1946 to describe an imaginary line that separated Communist countries in the Soviet bloc of Eastern Europe from countries in Western Europe
- 15 a U.S. policy, announced by President Harry S. Truman in 1947, of providing economic and military aid to free nations threatened by internal or external opponents
- 16 the blocking of another nation's attempts to spread its influence - especially the efforts of the United States to block the spread of Soviet influence during the late 1940s and early 1950s

- 1 the leader of Communist China who rose to power after World War II
- 2 the state of hostility, without direct military conflict, that developed between the United States and the Soviet Union after World War II
- 3 confinement or restriction in movement, especially under wartime conditions
- 4 a 327-day operation in which U.S. and British planes flew food and supplies into West Berlin after the Soviets blockaded the city in 1948
- 6 a country that is dominated politically and economically by another nation
- 10 a conflict between North Korea and South Korea, lasting from 1950 to 1953, in which the United States, along with other UN countries, fought on the side of the South Koreans and China fought on the side of the North Koreans
