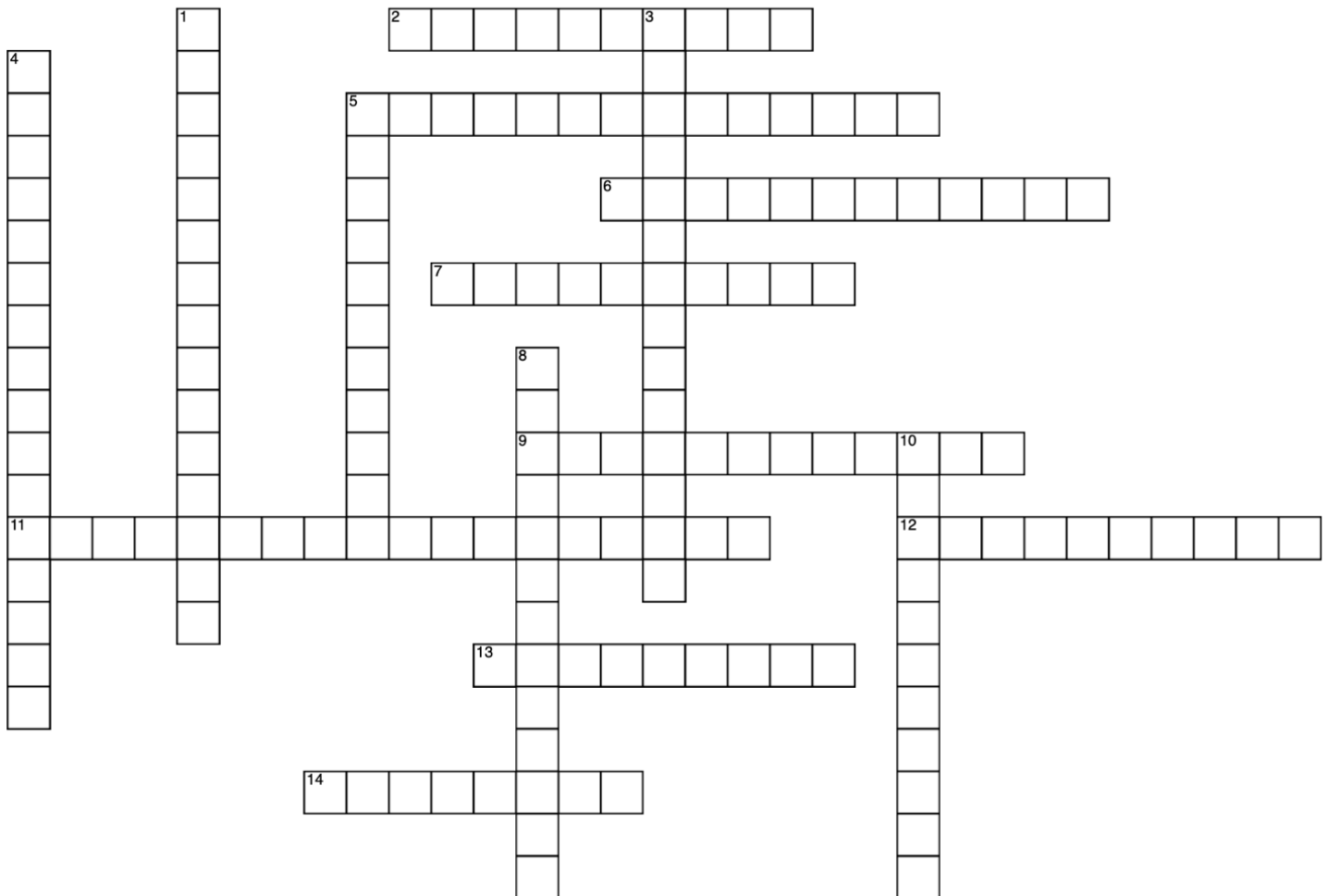

- 2 The weapon used to attack Hiroshima and Nagasaki (Japan) at the end of WWII. Still causes controversy today.
- 5 Battlefront during WWII on the Pacific Coast.
- 6 Britain, France, United States, Soviet Union.
- 7 Germany, Italy, Japan.
- 9 The U.S. president could lend, lease arms and supplies to any country considered vital to the United States during WWII.
- 11 Nazis officials ordered attacks on Jews in Germany, Austria, and Sudetenland. More than 1,500 synagogues, 7,500 Jewish-owned businesses were destroyed.
- 12 information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote or publicize a particular political cause or point of view.
- 13 The killing of the 6 million Jews because it was a war of extermination designed to wipe out an entire group of people.
- 14 destructive air raids over cities of Britain, including London.

- 1 Battlefront during WWII in Central Europe.
- 3 Major battle in the pacific that moved Japan from the offensive to the defensive with the United States.
- 4 Allied Powers were trapped off the shore of France. Not enough warships to transport all men stranded on beaches, so all citizens in possession of sea-worthy vessels were asked to lend their ships (British implemented Operation Dynamo).
- 5 Attack by Japan on U.S. Naval Base in Hawaii. Led to U.S. Involvement in WWII.
- 8 Military strategy used by the U.S. in the Pacific Theater (hop past Japanese strongholds in Pacific then seize control of islands poorly defended).
- 10 Foreign policy of pacifying an upset nation through negotiation in order to prevent war. Used to settle Germany after Treaty of Versailles.
